Position Profile:

Reporting to the Director of Manufacturing, the Product Manager is responsible for overseeing strategic plans for the successful commercialization of our client's products. Client relationship management

- Ensure sustaining and change control activities are quoted accurately and completed on time and on budget.
- Drive manufacturing transfer activities to ensure commercialization milestones are met, utilizing resources from other StarFish departments.
- Ownership and accountability for client key performance metrics, including reviews and future actions to shepherd the product through its full lifecycle.
